- Maximum capacity 70 guests




# Floral TIDE

# Tropical ELEGANCE





## 12+ months

- Settle on your budget

## 10-12 months

- Book hotel room blocks and transportation
- Secure the ceremony and reception venues
- Send out Save-the-Dates
- Plan your entertainment (music and performances)
- Plan any additional wedding-related events (rehearsal dinner, cocktail, afterparty, etc.)
- Create your gift registry
- **Secure your special day with the first deposit**

## 6-9 months

- Purchase your airline tickets
- Have a pre-wedding photo session
- **Book a wedding-related event (rehearsal dinner, cocktail, afterparty, etc.)**
- Design wedding invitations
- Set dates and locations for bridal showers and bachelor/bachelorette parties
- Shop for wedding rings
- Shop and arrange fitting for wedding attire
- Buy bridal accessories: shoes, headpiece, jewelry, garter, lingerie

## 4-5 months

- Send out formal wedding invitations
- Check your guests' dietary requirements
- Find out how many children will be attending
- **Finalize all the menus and beverage packages**
- **Pick your wedding cake flavor**
- **Order wedding favors / welcome gifts for guests**
- Start brainstorming a slideshow of memories
- **Book your entertainment and performances**
- Create your music playlist/song for walking down the aisle / first dance
- **Finalize the flower concept (bridal bouquet, bridesmaid's bouquets, groom/groomsmen's boutonnieres, centerpieces, etc.)**
- **Settle your special day with the second deposit**

# Wedding

## PLANNING TIMELINE

### 2-3 months

- Confirm the final headcount to the hotel
- Finalize ceremony & reception program
- Write your vows and choose the readings for your ceremony
- Discuss with the officiant about your ceremony proceedings
- Finish personalized decorations (photos, guestbook, etc.)
- Book photographer/videographer
- Send your music playlist/song for walking down the aisle and/or first dance
- **Settle your special day with the third deposit**

### 1 month

- Have your final gown fitting
- Complete the guest list and table seating plan
- Organize the rooming list
- Make arrangements to have welcome bags delivered to guests' rooms
- Pick the final design of name cards, menu and seating chart
- Send your slideshow of memories
- Book hair and makeup artist
- Arrange for a final wedding attire fitting
- **Settle your special day with the final deposit**

### Within 1 week

- Confirm details with your ceremony officiant
- Do a walk-through or rehearsal at the ceremony site a day prior to the wedding
- Arrange a time to have your bouquet and groom's boutonnieres delivered to you before the ceremony
- Reconfirm salon or spa appointments (e.g. facial, hair, makeup, nails)
